

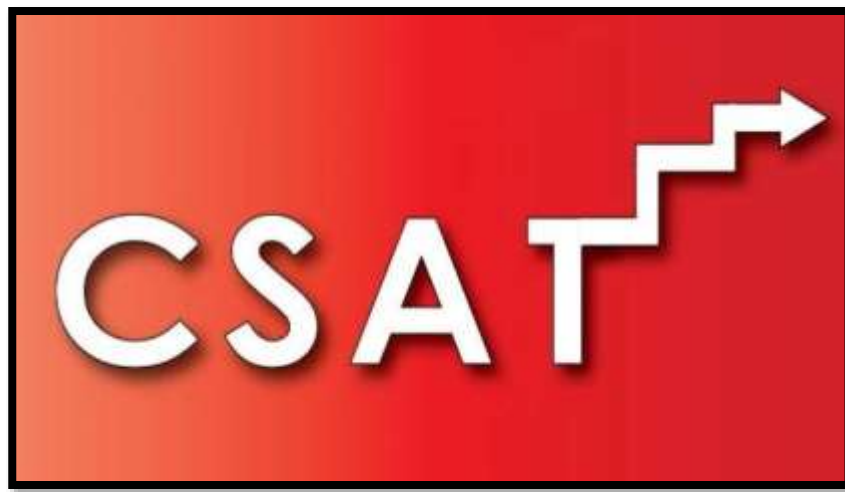

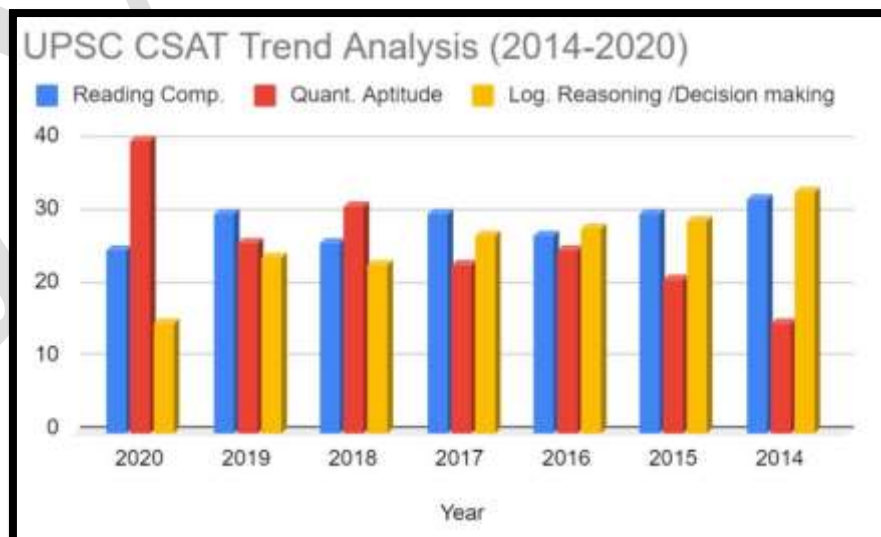
CSAT

The UPSC CSAT Syllabus is designed to analyze the aptitude and analytical skills of the candidates. A total of 200 marks questions are asked from CSAT Syllabus in the UPSC Preliminary exam.

UPSC CSAT Paper 2 is a qualifying paper, candidates need to score at least 33% to qualify for this paper.

The UPSC Paper 2 Syllabus will comprise the following topics

1. Comprehension
2. Interpersonal skills including communication skills
3. Logical reasoning and analytical ability
4. Decision-making and problem-solving
5. General mental ability
6. Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency, etc. – Class X level)
