Syllabus Topics:

Important Geophysical phenomena such as earthquakes, Tsunami, Volcanic activity, cyclone etc., geographical features and their location- changes in critical geographical features (including water-bodies and ice-caps) and in flora and fauna and the effects of such changes.

UPSC has been asking the questions in this manner ever since the change of the pattern for prelims in 2011 and for mains in 2013. Besides the conventional topics, Jatin Verma will cover relevant sections of Second ARC, Sarkaria Commission on Centre-State relations, Punchhi Commission on Centre-State Relations and Law commission reports on issues like Death Penalty, Electoral Reforms.
